## Kid's Booth Agreement

### INFORMATION FOR KID'S BOOTH

The kid's program has been a wonderful addition to the Woodstock Farmers Market and helps us accomplish part of our mission to provide a central community gathering place while promoting healthy eating, food education and fun.

The Woodstock Farmers Market will provide a covered canopy, table, chairs and sign identifying the individual/organization and activity, and the individual/organization hosting the booth needs to provide the activity and all appropriate materials.

### KID'S BOOTH POLICY

Individuals that utilize the Kid's Booth at the Woodstock Farmers Market:

1. must be a kid-focused business or promote a kid-focused program;
2. will be selected at the discretion of the Market Manager
3. must provide an activity for children from 10:00 a.m. – 1:45 p.m.;
4. setup is from 9:30 – 10:00 a.m.;
5. must be completely set up by 10:00 a.m.;
6. must be completely packed up and clear booth of all materials by 2:15 p.m.;
7. must check in with the Market Manager upon arrival and exit. If Market Manager is unavailable, individual must check in and out with the Info Booth;
8. may not sell items (this includes raffle tickets) from the booth or fundraise (this includes donation jars and in-kind services);
9. may have promotional materials for organization on display;
10. may not walk through the market handing out information or soliciting;
11. are welcome to apply for more than one market date per season as the schedule allows;
12. may not trade or transfer a scheduled date to another individual or group without the consent of the Market Manager;
13. must call at least 3 days in advance if unable to show for a scheduled date;

### POLICY IMPLEMENTATION:

1. Market Manager will distribute the policy to all interested parties.
2. Market Manager, with the support of the Board, will work to enforce the policy during the market if any individual is in violation of the stipulations.
